





Faust.js: the headless framework for WordPress

- Faust.js re-released on September 30th, 2022
 - Full template hierarchy support
 - Plugins
 - Authentication and more
- Gutenberg Block Support NEW
 - Blocks are now fully accessible from the front-end as data objects with all parameters and more
- Headless Toolbar NEW
 - Edit content, debug connections and more from your headless front-end just like the core
 WordPress toolbar



Atlas search: tailor-made for headless WordPress

- GraphQL-first
 - No proprietary API
 - Fully extensible
- Full feature set:
 - Full ACF and Custom Post Type Support
 - Faceted browsing
 - Weighted/custom results
 - Stemming, Fuzziness, Exclusions
- No limits on search actions or bandwidth
